Day 1: Mark 5: 21-43 (Whole Story)

Day 2: Mark 5: 21-24, 35-43 (Jairus' Daughter)

Day 3: Mark 5: 25-34 (Hemorhaging Woman)

Day 4: Mark 5: 21-43 (Whole Story)

What changed from Day 1 to Day 4? What did God reveal to you through your indepth prayer with this passage?
